


Jelly Roll Split Blade Dresden Wall Hanging Supply List

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Create this Jelly Roll Split Blade Dresden while learning the Modern Stitch-n-Flip method of piecing. This project is done using fat quarters or Jelly Roll Strips cut 2 1/2. can be used for the blades, border and binding.

Fabric needed and cutting- Note cutting is for using Fat Quarters that are approx 21" long.

	Placement	Colors	Yardage Amount	First Cut	Sub-Cut
A	Block Background	Light	1 Fat Quarter	2 Strip 6 1/2" wide	Cut into 4 6 1/2" Squares
B	Side Setting Triangles	Medium	1 Fat Quarter	1 Strip 8" wide	Cut into 2 8 " squares Cut diagonally once 
C	Dresden Blades	Medium	1 Fat Quarter	Cut 4 Strips 2 1/2"	Sew Strip C to Strip D Press Seams open. Cut to 5 1/4" lengths
D	Dresden Blades	Dark	1 Fat Quarter	Cut 4 strips 2 1/2"	
E	Outer Border	Med Dark	1 Fat Quarter	*Cut 8 strips 2 1/2" wide	*Cut along selvage as crosswise will not be wide enough.
F	Binding Center Circle	Dark Dark	1 Fat Quarter	Cut 4 strips 2 1/4"	
	Backing		Can be pieced with leftovers or 3/4 yard		
	Batting		23" by 23"		

Please have cutting done before class. We will cut the blade shape out in class. Other Supplies Needed

Finished size is 19" by 19"

- Jelly Roll Split Blade Wall Hanging Pattern (I will bring to class)
- Thread to match for piecing
- Template Plastic or Freezer Paper
- Pencil
- Scissors for fabric and paper
- Fabric friendly marking tool
- Water Soluble fabric glue
- Basic Sewing supplies such as sewing machine, scissors, seam ripper, straight pins etc.
- Iron and Small Ironing surface
- Rotary cutting tools- Cutter, ruler and board
- Freezer Paper (I will bring to class)
- Starch (I will in class for students to use)
- Turning tool such as "Purple Thang"
- Dresden Template by Fast2Cut (Optional) (I will have templates to use in class.)
